Snyder Talks About 'Change For The Sake Of Change'

Gov. Rick SNYDER said today he doesn't support "change for the sake of change" as it relates to using technology in the classroom. However, he said he sees technology as being an instrument of value . . . to help that high school student struggling with the Algebra 2 learn a concept he or she may have missed in the 6th grade.

Snyder was speaking to about 60 school officials and lawmakers at the Mackinac Center's "Online Learning Revolution" co-hosted by former Democratic West Virginia Gov. Bob WISE, who is now the president of the Alliance for Excellent Education. In that new role he focuses on on-line education.

Snyder said on-line learning is not about the technology or about the buzzwords, but seeing real results for "real people."
