

# John Mackey CO-CEO, Whole Foods Market

John P. Mackey is the founder of Whole Foods Market and has served as co-Chief Executive Officer since 2010. Mr. Mackey also served as president from June 2001 to October 2004, and as chairman of the board from 1978 to December 2009. As the company's visionary, he has led the development of such innovative programs as the \$10 million in low-interest loans to local farmers and food producers to help them expand their businesses, the Whole Planet Foundation, whose mission is to help end poverty in developing nations with microcredit, a welfare rating system that improves the welfare of food animals, and a labeling system that creates transparency for seafood sustainability. Mr. Mackey's most recent focus is reinvigorating Whole Foods Market's emphasis on healthy eating and lifestyle choices. An active promoter of the new business paradigm termed "Conscious Capitalism," he is also co-founder of a non-profit organization by that name.


