Request Type: FOIA Request

Description: In accordance with the Michigan Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), MI LARA provides copies of its public records. Records which are exempt from disclosure by state or federal law will not be provided. You are encouraged to check the MI LARA website to see if the record you wish to obtain is available online.

The Freedom of Information Act does not require governmental bodies to create new records or answer questions. A request must ask for records or information already in existence.

We will respond within five business days to a request. If needed, we may issue a notice extending for up to 10 additional business days.
