COMPLAINT

There is no other pending or resolved civil action arising out of the same transaction or occurrence alleged in the complaint.

NOW COMES Plaintiff, The Mackinac Center for Public Policy, and for its Complaint alleges and states as follows:

INTRODUCTION

The plaintiff, the Mackinac Center for Public Policy (the "Mackinac Center") is a nonprofit organization dedicated to improving the quality of life for all Michigan residents by promoting sound solutions to state and local policy questions. To that end, the Mackinac Center routinely uses the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") to obtain relevant documents from state and local governments.

On February 17, 2025, the Mackinac Center, by and through its employee, Jamie Hope, made a routine request to Flint Community Schools ("FCS"), seeking the expense reports submitted to FCS for school-related trips by FCS staff, administrative officials, and school board members. Under the FOIA, FCS was required to respond to this request no later than five business days from the date of receipt, or February 24, 2025. MCL 15.235(2). The Mackinac Center received no response to its initial request.

On March 11, 2025 (a full sixteen business days after the Mackinac Center submitted its original request), the Center sent another communication to FCS requesting a status update. In response, FCS indicated that it had received the Center's request and was "working on it." In light of the fact this response contained none of the information required by MCL 15.234(8), and was untimely under MCL 15.235(2), the Mackinac Center sent additional correspondence demanding compliance with the requirements of the FOIA on March 11, 2025. The Center received no response.

To date, the Center has not received any correspondence or records from FCS beyond its initial vague assurances that its request was being worked on. This suit follows, as FCS has failed to fulfill even the most rudimentary requirements of the FOIA.

PARTIES, JURISDICTION, AND VENUE

- 1. Plaintiff, the Mackinac Center for Public Policy (the "Mackinac Center"), is a Michigan nonprofit corporation headquartered in Midland County, Michigan.
- 2. Defendant, Flint Community Schools ("FCS"), is a municipal corporation and public body which is headquartered in Genesee County, Michigan.
- 3. Venue is proper pursuant to MCL 15.240(1)(b).
- 4. Pursuant to MCL 15.240(5), this action should be "assigned for hearing and trial or for argument at the earliest practicable date and expedited in every way."
- 5. Pursuant to MCL 15.240(1)(b) and MCL 600.605, the circuit court has jurisdiction over this claim.

VIOLATIONS OF THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

- 6. The Plaintiff hereby incorporates the preceding paragraphs as if fully restated herein.
- 7. On February 17, 2025, Mackinac Center employee Jamie Hope submitted a FOIA request to FCS for the following records:
 - A copy of all expense reports submitted to the District for in-state and out-of-state school related trips for staff, administration officials, and school board members in 23 and 2024.
 - If there are no records responsive to the request immediately above, a copy of any records submitted to the district which itemize the costs associated with any trips for the years referenced above.

Exhibit A, Mackinac Center's FOIA Request and Related Correspondence.

- 8. FCS did not respond to the Mackinac Center's request within the five (5) business day period required by MCL 15.235(2).
- 9. Having received no response whatsoever, the Mackinac Center contacted the FCS on March 11, 2025, to determine the status of its request. **Exhibit A.**

10. On March 11, 2025, an unknown FCS employee responded to the Mackinac Center's request thusly:

"Hello,

We have received your request and are working on it."

The response contained no additional information about the estimated cost of the request, the time period in which the Mackinac Center could expect it to be fulfilled, or any attachments. **Exhibit A.**

- 11. March 11, 2025 was sixteen (16) business days after the Mackinac Center submitted its original request, meaning FCS would have failed to respond within the time period permitted by MCL 15.235(2) even if it had taken a 10-business day extension.
- 12. MCL 15.231(2) states:

It is the public policy of this state that all persons, except those persons incarcerated in state or local correctional facilities, are entitled to fully and complete information regarding the affairs of government and the official acts of those who represent them as public officials and public employees, consistent with this act. The people shall be informed so that they may participate in the democratic process.

- 13. MCL 15.235(2) requires a public body to respond to a FOIA request within five (5) business days. That response must be either a grant of the request, a denial of the request, or a ten (10) business day extension of the period to respond. *Id*.
- 14. The Mackinac Center's request was filed on February 17, 2025. Thus, FCS' response was due no later than February 24, 2025. **See Exhibit A.**
- 15. At time of writing, it has been fifty (50) business days since the Center filed its request. FCS has not responded in the fashion required by MCL 15.235(2).
- 16. Thus, FCS has violated FOIA by failing to respond within the five (5) business days as required by MCL 15.235(2).

- 17. Under MCL 15.235(3), a failure to respond to a written request constitutes a public body's final determination to deny the request if the request included language conveying a request for information within the first two hundred and fifty (250) words of the body of an e-mail. MCL 15.235(3) specifically cites communications including the words "freedom of information" or "FOIA" as satisfying this requirement.
- 18. The subject line of the Mackinac Center's request was "FOIA Request." Exhibit A.
- 19. The initial clause of the request read: "Pursuant to the Michigan Freedom of Information Act, MCL 15.231 et seq.," Exhibit A.
- 20. Thus, under MCL 15.235(3), FCS' failure to respond within the time period required by MCL 15.235(2) constitutes a final determination denying the Center's request.
- 21. MCL 15.235(8) permits the Center to commence this civil action to appeal FCS' final determination to deny the Center's request.
- 22. FCS' failure to respond to the Center's request is arbitrary and capricious under MCL 15.240(7), thereby subjecting it to a civil fine of \$1,000.00 payable to the general treasury and a separate \$1,000.00 to the Mackinac Center.
- 23. FCS' failure to respond as required by MCL 15.235(2) constitutes a willful and intentional failure to comply under MCL 15.240b, thereby subjecting it to a civil fine of \$2,500 to \$7,500 payable to the state treasury.

RELIEF REQUESTED

Plaintiff, Mackinac Center for Public Policy, respectfully requests that this Court order Defendant, Flint Community Schools, to provide all documents sought in the FOIA request in unredacted form; apply the full penalties available under MCL 15.234(9), MCL 15.240(7), and

MCL 15.240b; and award any other relief this Court determines to be just and equitable to remedy

FCS' failure to produce the requested information and causing the need to bring this suit.
